INTRODUCTION

Zambia is one of the finest, if not the best, dangerous game hunting grounds in Africa. There are 18 National Parks covering over 14 million acres, and hunting concessions totaling in excess of 34 million acres. A third of the entire country is set aside to wildlife, which means it is an African safari paradise.



The majority of our Zambian safaris take place on the concessions adjacent to the North and South Luangwa National Parks. The Luangwa Valley has long been one of the best areas in Africa if you are looking for truly huge lion, leopard, buffalo and other plains game. We also conduct safaris on a few of the prime concessions around the Kafue National Park that offer tremendous dangerous game as well as sable, roan and other plains game. Everyone traveling to Zambia should plan on adding a few extra days for species like Kafue & Black Lechwe, Sitatunga, Tsessebe and Oribi.

CHANJUZI, LUANGWA VALLEY

Traditionally known for its consistently large full maned lion, Chanjuzi GMA also boasts huge leopard and big, full-bosser buffalo. Located in the Luangwa Valley, and bordering three national parks including the North Luangwa National Park, Chanjuzi totals over 630,000 acres of prime hunting grounds encompassing mopane woodlands, sweeping hills and superb Luangwa River frontage.

Hunters fly to the Waka-Waka airstrip, and drive 10 to 20 minutes to camp. Buffalo hunts are a minimum 7 days while the Classic Safaris are 14 days for leopard, 18 days for lion or 21 to 24 days for both.

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TONDWA, LAKE TANGYANIKA

Located in North Zambia, close to the shores of Lake Tanganyika, Tondwa is a rich and diverse Game Management Area covering 443 square kilometers. With beautiful wetlands and bordering hills it boasts of an unbeatable African landscape. The area is well known for its large Roan, Blue Duiker and Sitatunga. Species common to the area are sable (among the biggest in Africa), baboon, buffalo, bushbuck, bushpig, Common duiker, blue duiker, Livingstone's Eland, Grysbok, Lichenstein Hartebeest, Hippo, Leopard, Lion, Puku, Oribi, Reedbuck, warthog and zebra. Tondwa is reached by a 20 hour drive, air charter or when available by commercial flight into Kasaba Bay (currently Tuesday and Fridays US\$450 per person return.)

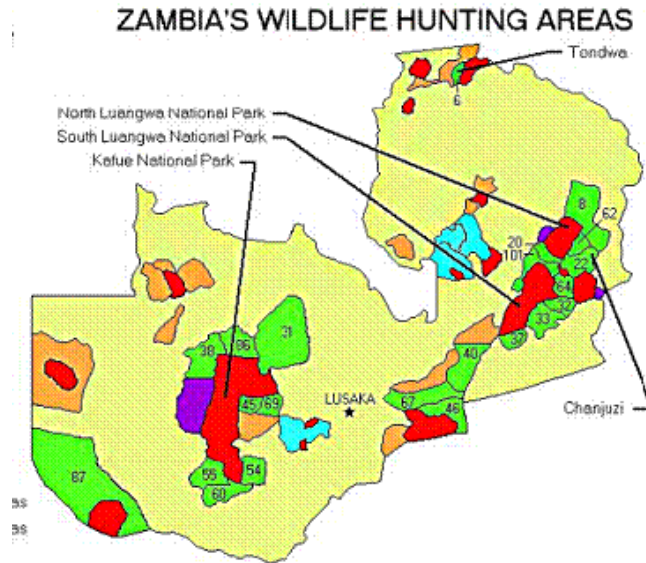
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SAFARI RATES EXCLUDE

- *Trophy Fees (Trophy Fees & Concession fees are liable to change with government policy, Zambian Wildlife Authority, etc.)*
- *Ammunition and hire of firearms.*
- *Any air charter fares (International and/or Local). Quote provided for each safari.*
- *Alcohol and tobacco and Custom duty on Ammunition.*
- *Bird License compulsory for all hunters US \$120.*
- *Change of area fee US \$1000 per hunter.*
- *Ground transfer fee: Lusaka - Tondwa, Lusaka - Bangweulu, or Mfuwe - Chanjusi; US \$500 per vehicle.*
- *Gratuities for camp staff and PH.*
- *Zambian Entry Visa: approximately US \$25, Airport departure tax \$20.*
- *Dipping and packing charges of trophies.*
- *Air freight of trophies and shipping agent handling charges. All shipping agent and air freight fees for trophy export are the responsibility of the client.*
